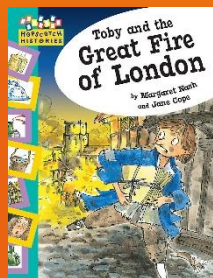
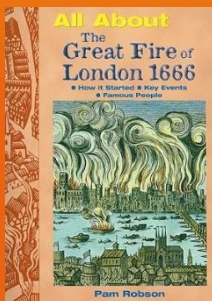
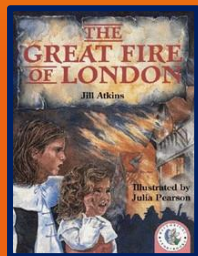

What Am I Learning?

Identify when the Great Fire of London happened / Identify the key events in the Great Fire of London / Explain how the past is represented

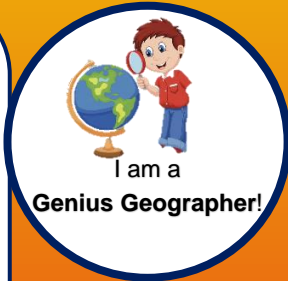


What Am I Learning?

Select and order sounds / Represent sounds with symbols / Play musical instruments / Identify beat / Explore how sounds can be organised.

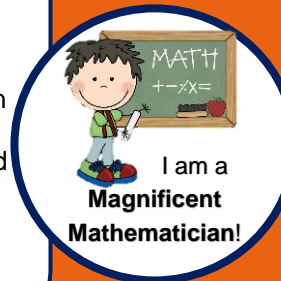


At Glastonbury Thorn School, we follow **White Rose** maths.

What Am I Learning?

To count forwards and backwards within 100 / To represent numbers to 100 / To use the part-whole model using tens and ones / To compare and order numbers to 100 / To count in 2s, 5s and 10s / To know number bonds to 100 / To know 10 more and 10 less / To add and subtract a 2-digit and 1-digit number / To add and subtract two 2-digit numbers / To add three 1-digit numbers.

I can: Identify the place value of any 2-digit number / To count forwards and backwards within 100 / To add and subtract using number bonds and the part-whole model.

Who should you follow? To understand who is important and why? / To recognise what makes religious people special / To understand how special people influence us / To reflect on the perfect person!
