In EYFS we explored art through play and investigation. We learnt to:

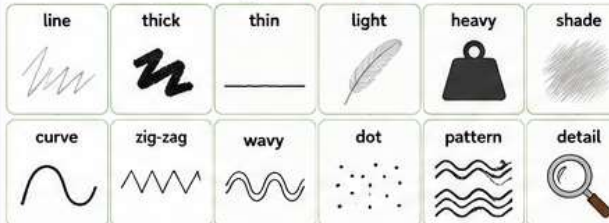
- ✓ Explore different marks and materials.

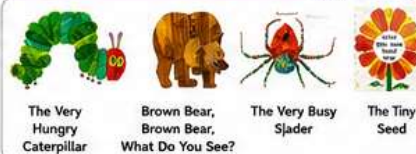

Eric Carle is an American author and illustrator. He is best known for his beautiful picture books using collage and bright colours.



🌍 SUPER ARTIST! – Exploring and creating like artists

DRAWING WITH WAX CRAYONS Make thick and thin lines

Press lightly
for light lines.



Press heavily
for thick dark lines.



We can make lots of different lines and marks.



We can add detail, texture and shading.



COLLAGE: Cut and paste for effect

Cut, tear and choose materials.



Layer and overlap for effect.



We can make shapes, pictures and patterns.

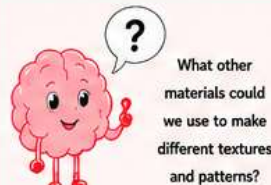
MAKE CONNECTIONS – TALK ABOUT IT!
