What can we remember?

In Year One we learned to:

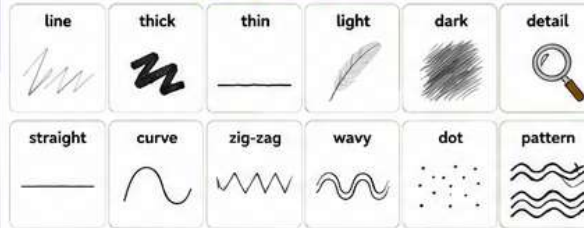
- ✓ Make thick and thin lines using wax crayons.

Artist Focus – Henri Matisse (1869–1954)



Henri Matisse was a French artist known for his bold colours and cut-out collages.

He said, "I want to create art that is like a comfortable armchair to rest in."

SUPER ARTIST! – Exploring and creating like artists

DRAWING WITH PENCILS

With increasing accuracy, detail and control

Draw with control inside the space.



Use different lines to create patterns.



Create light and dark areas (shading).



Add detail to make your drawing look realistic.



Draw from real objects and add texture.



Choose colours for effect.



DESCRIBE AND COMPARE

We can look carefully at artwork and talk about it.

What do you like about this artwork?

What colours can you see?

What is the same? What is different?

COLLAGE

With increasing accuracy and more purpose

Cut carefully using scissors.



Tear, layer and overlap for different effects.



Use colours, patterns and textures.



Fold, scrunch and shape materials.



Apply glue appropriately.



Combine materials to create a finished artwork.
