A high sound is a higher pitch.

low



A low sound is a lower pitch.

middle



A sound in the middle range.

instructions



Directions that tell us what to do.

create



To make or bring into being.

choose



To pick or select something.

response



A reaction or answer to something.

rehearse



To practise and get ready to perform.

pulse



The steady beat.

rhythm



Long and short sounds put together.

pitch



How high or low a sound is.

dynamics



How loud or quiet the music is.

timbre



The quality or type of sound.

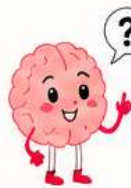


MAKE CONNECTIONS – TALK ABOUT IT!
