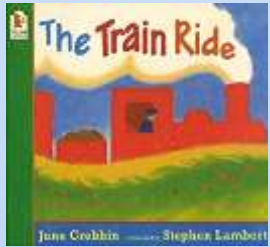
What Am I Learning?

I can:

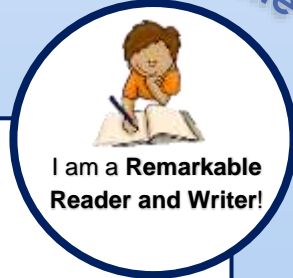
- Recognise what is kind and unkind behaviour.

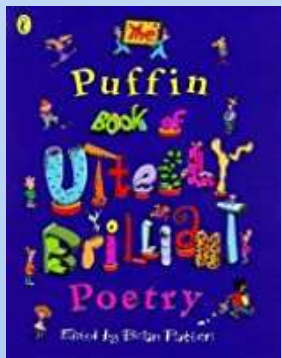

- Know that Queen Victoria reigned during the Victorian period.

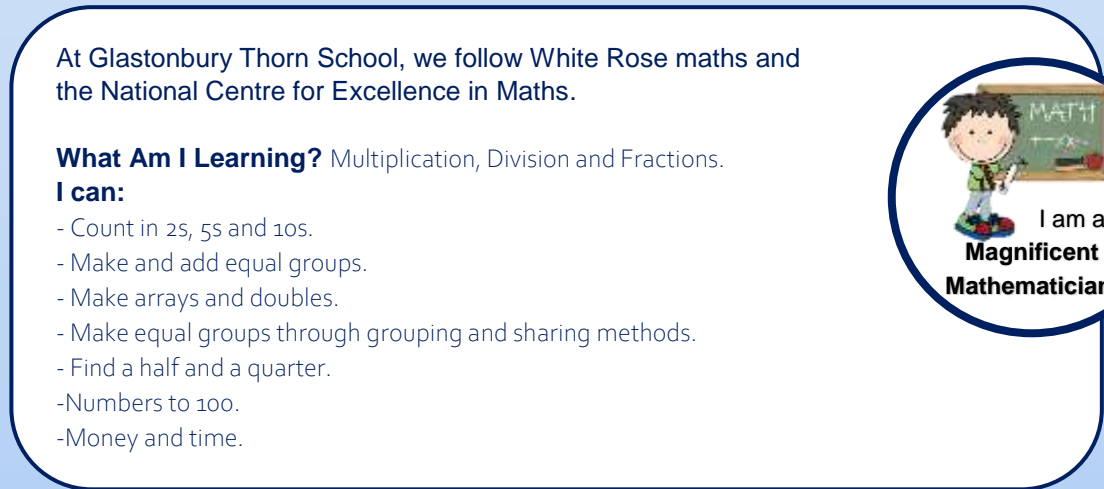

What Am I Learning?

 Striking and fielding

I can:

- To retrieve an object using hands

- To hand strike a ball towards a target from 5-10m
